

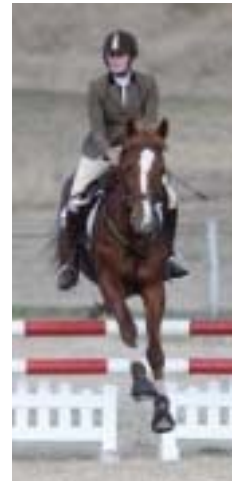


August Newsletter

Fantastic new jumps and trailer purchased, these were used in the 1st ring in the main arena at the world cup show.

Next year there will be a introduction of a volunteer levy; it has discussed that this will be \$25 for individuals and \$50 for members, in addition to membership fees. The money generated from this levy would be held in a separate account and may be rolled over each year if volunteering completed, or returned if volunteering complete and member wishes to exit club, you forfeit if volunteering is not performed.

This is to cover the cost of paying scouts or other organisations to cover typically 'volunteer' roles.

Congratulations to Averil Hawthorne who rode her World Cup Showjumper to over 70% in both her tests.

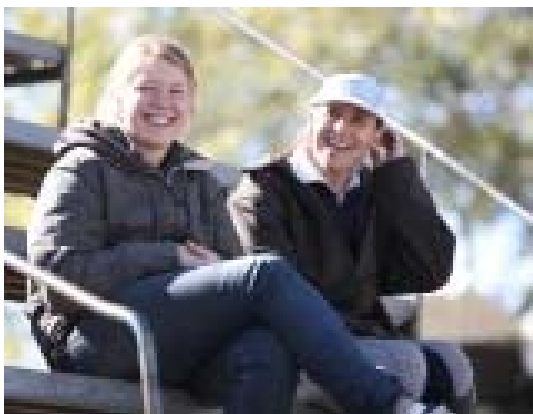
Annie Johnstone and her team put up 4 dressage arenas in 1 hour!!
